



## **TAYNUILT GOLF CLUB - Proposed New Club House**

At the committee meeting held on Monday 18<sup>th</sup> August it was reported that an officer from the Planning Department had visited the site of the proposed club house, on land close to the first tee, and had made very encouraging remarks. We will now proceed to apply for detailed planning permission.. The proposed building will consist of a spacious main club room, changing rooms, toilets and a good sized kitchen.

Over the past two years we have raised over £15,000 but we need a minimum of a further £20,000. As a means of achieving this the Committee is asking each member to attempt to raise £100. This might be by getting sponsorship for a specific challenge , such as a cycle ride or a hill climb, or by doing gardening, or baby sitting, or ironing for friends or by organising a coffee morning . The possibilities are endless but at the end of the day the member would have raised money towards the new building. Some may decide they would rather write a cheque.

The Committee has decided that it is important that the identity of members, who support this campaign, and equally those who choose not to, remains confidential. The Treasurer will simply issue a certificate to members who have succeeded in raising £100 in the same way that certificates were issued to the founding members 21 years ago.

The final push is now on. Some members have already come up with ideas and are starting to raise money. Ideally we would like to raise at least 50% of the money before Christmas but we will be continuing our efforts right into next season. If you have a successful idea, don't limit your fund raising to £100. Similarly if you fall short of this target it doesn't matter. All contributions, large or small, will be gratefully received. However once you have raised £100 your certificate will be issued.

Just as at the conception of the golf course, we are also going to approach local businesses for sponsorship and their support will be acknowledged by putting their names on a board in the new club house.

All contributions from individuals who are also tax payers may be given using the Gift Aid scheme. We will then be able to reclaim, at present, 28p for each £1 given.
